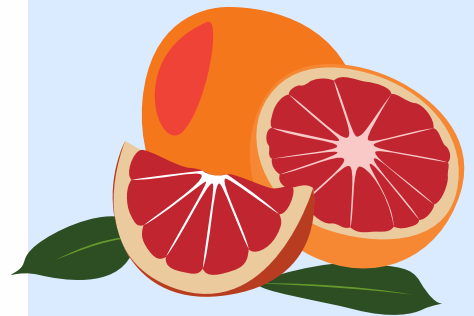

- Toothbrush holder

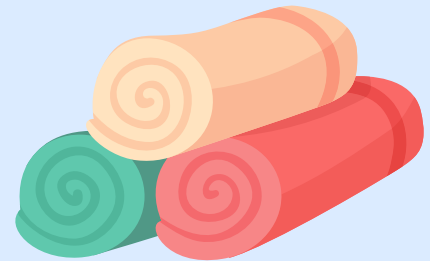
SUPPLEMENTAL ITEMS
